- I. EDMUND RICE m. Thomasine Frost in England. They settled in Sudbury, Mass., 1639.
- II. THOMAS RICE b. England, came to New England with parents, m. Mary King.
- III. MARY RICE b. Sudbury, Mass., 4 Sept. 1656. mar. 28 Nov. 1678 JOSIAH WHITE, son of John White and Joan West of England who came to Salem, 1639. Josiah and Mary White lived in Lancaster, Mass. where he was Commander of garrison house. He d. 11 Nov. 1714. She m. (2nd) Thomas Sawyer. Children of Mary and Josiah: Sarah, Josiah Jr., JOHN, Thankful, Jonathan, Judith, Kesiah.
- IV. JOHN WHITE b. Lancaster, 20 Sept. 1684, mar. Eunice WILDER dau. of Lt. Nathaniel and Mary Sawyer Wilder. John White was known as "Capt. John White", Indian fighter. His home was Lancaster, Mass. He died Sept. 12, 1725, she d. May 15, 1778. Children: Mary m. Rev. Rowlandson, and John Jr.
- V. JOHN WHITE II, Revolutionary War Soldier, b. 1714; m. 19 Mar. 1735 Lois WILDER, dau. of Judge Joseph Wilder; resided in Lancaster, Mass. He d. 21 Feb. 1797. she d. 2 Dec. 1790. Children: John, TILLEY.
- VI. TILLEY WHITE, Revolutionary War Soldier, served in Machias and Castine, Maine, then Massachusetts. Lived in Addison, Me. Tilly White was b. 3 Sept. 1736, Lancaster, Mass. m. (2) Tamson WILLEY, b. Harrington, Me. 1749. He d. 14 Feb. 1810, she died 1825. Children by 2nd wife, Abijah, Eunice, John, Rachel, Jonathan, Ephraim, Lucy, William, Lois, Elizabeth, ICHABOD.
- VII. ICHABOD WHITE b. 4 Sept. 1791; m. (2) Pamela NASH, in 1827. She was b. 1806 and died 1889. They lived in Columbia, Me. He carried the mail over stage line that passed his home. The rough roads caused his death from a broken neck on 5 November 1867. Children: Nathaniel, Israel, Woodbury, Thomas Ashbury, Daniel, Calvin, Lucinda, Clarissa, Levi, JAMES, Alfred, Betsey, Augustus, Nathaniel, Forrest, Philander, Theodore. Some children b. before JAMES by 1st. wife.

VIII. JAMES WHITE, b. 6 May 1831, d. 26 Jan. 1914. He was a sea Captain and took his family with him on many foreign voyages. He m. Nancy Jane RAMSDELL\*, 19 Oct. 1849. She was a descendant of Joseph RAMSDELL, sometimes spelled RAMSDEN, and wife Rachel EATON, dau. of Mayflower passenger, FRANCIS EATON. Children: Daniel, SYLVIA, Warren, Rosa, Genie, Annie d.y. and Gilbert.

IX. SYLVIA LOUISE WHITE, b. 2 July, 1856, mar. (2nd) Captain George H. Frye, b. 1853. He was master part owner of brig "Mary E. Pennell" on which he died in Halifax Harbor, 1931. Sylvia d. in Addison, Me., 15 Aug. 1943. Their home was Harrington, Me. in village called Fryeville. Child: Samuel Moody FRYE.

X. SAMUEL MOODY FRYE, b. 19 Oct. 1883, d. 1960 in Bar Harbor, Me. mar. Eldusta Merrill FREETHY of Surry, Me., descendant of Roger Conant, Governor of early settlers of Salem, Mass., then Nahum-Keike, and also from the Rev. Daniel MERRILL, Revolutionary soldier, 1789 graduate of Dartmouth College, and minister in Sedgwick, Maine in 1791. Eldusta Free-ty was b. 22 Oct. 1887, m. 3 Oct. 1906 Brewer, Me. Children: FLORENCE and Elwood Merrill. He mar. Evelyn Wood, and their dau. Pamela m. Howard Harper Jr.; their child, Wayne.

XI. FLORENCE FRYE, b. 17 April 1914, mar. Feb. 10 1940 in Bangor, Me., Johnson Edward VIVIAN, M.I.T. Prof-essor; b. 6 July 1913 Montreal Canada. Children: John Edward, b. 19 June 1943 Buffalo, N.Y., David James, b. 24 Nov. 1945, and Ann, b. 8 Aug. 1952; both b. at Richardson House, Boston, Mass.
