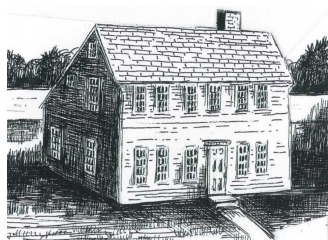

President's Column



Greetings, cousins!

Plans are progressing for the in-person reunion scheduled for September! See inside for the details.

Another item of interest to all genealogists is the release, earlier this year, of the 1950 US census. The odd rule followed by the Census Bureau of keeping the census confidential for 72 years, neither more nor less, is certainly loose enough that many persons still living are now revealed to the public, but it's strict enough that I am too young to have appeared in that census, even though I am now very definitely a senior citizen. Be that as it may, I was intrigued by the fact that this census release included an index right from the start. I was excited by the prospect of being able to use the new release right away, instead of having to wait an unknown period for the creation

of an index. At the time of the previous release (of the 1940 census in 2012), there were finding aids that would allow the user to home in on a specific Enumeration District if the exact address was known, but even then it was necessary to browse through the whole district to find that address. I went through that exercise for a limited number of relatives and was successful in every case, but I gained no useful new information as a result. This time promised to be different.

Then again, the 1950 index was machine-generated from hand-written documents created by a large number of different enumerators, with a wide variety of writing styles. By spot observation, I found that, seemingly, more than half of the names were either missing from the index or seriously garbled. I tried to look up my parents, who were then married and living in rural New Castle County, Delaware. The index allowed narrowing the field to a single county or major city, and so the names I wanted might well be unique. I first tried the combination of my father's first and last names, but that didn't find him. I then looked up all 20 or so instances of the name Chandler, still without finding the family. I next tried my father's first name, but again failed to find him. There were too many instances of my mother's first name to make it sensible to look at all of them, and so, no dice. I'll continue the saga in my next column.

Descendants of Edmund Rice were holding reunions as early as 1851, but it was not until 1912 that the Association was formed and officers elected. Incorporation under Massachusetts law took place in 1934.

Membership is open to anyone who claims to be a lineal descendant of Edmund Rice. Rigorous proof is not required and many members have been able to ascertain their pedigree only after access to the books and files of other members. Spouses are also eligible for membership.

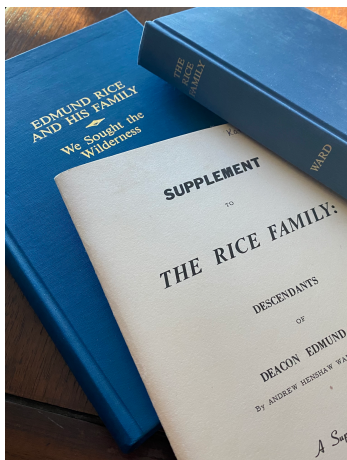

Hard-cover reprint. New, unused. A genealogical history of descendants of Deacon Edmund Rice who came from Berkhamstead, England, and settled in Sudbury, Massachusetts, in 1638. Includes a soft-cover supplement (1967) containing additions and corrections. 379 pages.
